


CS118 Program

Hello World

Since our programs will be run in Spyder, this program must begin with the command to clear the console:
`print('\x1b[2J')`

Using Spyder, prepare a Python3 program which will – using the `print()` function - print to the console the words “Hello, World!” followed by **two blank lines**, and then print to the console the words “I'm glad to be here!” (don't forget the apostrophe!) *with the command prompt showing up on the next line*. See the example output below:



```
Console 1/A x  
Hello, World!  
  
I'm glad to be here!  
In [4]: |
```

Don't forget your algorithm and affirmation!
