


Installing Python3 and Spyder on Windows

1. If you have Python2 or Python3 installed, remove all through Control Panel, including any tool installations labeled for Python. Then delete the `c:\python37` folder if it exists.
2. Double-click each of the install .bat scripts in order (00_, 01_, 02_, etc) waiting for each to complete before closing each window and starting the next script.
3. Place a shortcut to Spyder on the desktop:
 - Open a File Manager window to `c:\python37\Scripts\spyder3.exe`
 - While holding the **Ctrl** and **Shift** keys down...
 - ... drag and drop the shortcut on the desktop



Run Spyder by double-clicking on the desktop shortcut
